Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** This matter is taken off calendar.

#### **Case No. CV114- CSAA Insurance vs. Ferrellgas**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will hear argument on the Motion to Continue.

#### **Case No. CV15-00077 – Thornburg and DeGroat v. Parsons**

Tentative Ruling: **Denied.** Defendant Ralph Brooks Parsons' Motion to Quash Service of Summons is denied. The court has reviewed the motion and opposition, and finds that personal jurisdiction in California is appropriate here, in that Parsons was a non-resident defendant who caused injury while physically present in California. Defendant Ralph Brooks Parsons is ordered to file his answer within 10 days from the date of this decision. Plaintiff is to prepare the Order.

# CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE TENTATIVE RULINGS

## Case No. FL02-23382 – Mar. of Bresnyan

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will set the matter for a contested hearing.

## Case No. CV14-00156 – Sebring v. Peterson

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court has received a dismissal.

## Case No. CV15-00100 – Waller v. Page

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court notes that defendant has failed to file a case management conference statement. Should there be any further violations of Rule 3.725, this matter will be set for an order to show cause and sanctions may be imposed. The parties should be prepared to discuss ADR options and set a trial date.

## Case No. CV15-00054 – Bank of America v. Guillory

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court notes that defendant has again failed to file a case management conference statement. A previous warning was issued by the court on November 19, 2015, in its tentative ruling. The court will issue an order to show cause for failing to file a conference statement, and sanctions may be imposed. The court also notes there is no proof of service on the defendant in the file, nor any request for service by publication.

## Case No. CV12-00070 – Hessel v. Forderhase

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will discuss the status of the case with the parties.
