Case No. PR14-00008– Guardianship of Aswad

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court has not received the investigator's report.

Case No. PR14-00007 – Guardianship of Cabral

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court has not received the investigator's report. However, consents for guardianship have been filed by both parents. As a result, the court will grant the request for temporary guardianship. The court will continue the hearing on request for guardianship until March 24, 2014, at 9:00a.m., in order to receive and review the investigator's report.

Case No. PR10-00009 – Guardianship of Green

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court has reviewed the confidential guardianship status report and attachment from the Department of Social Services, and finds that continued guardianship is in the best interests of the minor. The court schedules the annual review for March 10, 2014, at 9:00a.m. The clerk of the court is reminded to send notice to the guardian one month prior to this date, informing the guardians of the duty to file a confidential status report prior to the review hearing.

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court has not received the investigator's report.

Case No. CV14-00041 – American Valley Pet vs. Labbe

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.**

Case No. CV13-00188 – Cobelis vs. Scribellito

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** Plaintiffs' Petition for Order Compelling Arbitration is granted. Unless there is an agreement on the arbitrator, the court will require both parties to submit three names of proposed arbitrators, and the court will choose an arbitrator. Plaintiffs are to prepare the Order.

Case No. LC08-28396 – First Investment Resolution Corp. vs. Houston

Tentative Ruling: **Denied.** Plaintiff's Motion to Deem Facts as Admitted is denied. Defendant filed a response to the motion; however, there is no proof of service in the file on the plaintiff. It appears to the court that plaintiff's motion was not served upon the defendant. The parties should be prepared to discuss ADR options and set a trial date.

Case No. CV12-00218 – Mondot v. Advanced Builders & Woodworking, Inc.

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.**

Case No. CV-00079 – Walters vs. Grizzly Lake Community Services District

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court notes there is no proof of service in the file on the defendant.

Case No. FL12-00071 – Hays vs. Seabolt

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court has not received the parenting plan recommendation. If a recommendation is filed prior to the hearing, the court will review the plan with the parties.

Case No. FL12-00224 – Mar. of Judd

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will hear the results of mediation. If there is no agreement, the court will order a recommendation, and continue the matter for six weeks.

Case No. FL13-00133 – Mar. of Riggins

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required, unless the parties have stipulated to a reservation of spousal support.**

Case No. FL13-00055 – Mar. of Smith

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will review the custody and visitation orders with the parties. As indicated at the last hearing, the court intends to modify father's Tuesday visitations to overnight, as a result of his clean drug testing.

Case No. FL13-00082 – Snyder vs. Moxley

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will discuss the custody and visitation plan with the parties. If there is no agreement, this matter may be continued to March 24, 2014, at 10:30a.m., or specially set for a contested hearing.

Case No. FL12-00199 – Mar. of Welch

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court has signed a custody and visitation agreement. As indicated in the agreement, the court will set a review hearing on June 9, 2014, at 10:30a.m.
