

## **Traffic School Information**

### ***You may be eligible for Traffic School if:***

- You have a valid California driver's license.
- You have not attended traffic school in the past 18 months.
- The citation does not involve any drug or alcohol violations.
- You were not speeding more than 25 mph over the posted limit.

Note: Commercial Drivers are not eligible for Traffic School if they were driving a commercial vehicle. Drivers with a commercial license may be eligible for traffic school if they were driving a non-commercial vehicle. Any conviction for a driver with a commercial license driving a non-commercial vehicle is not confidential. However, completion of traffic school will mean that no violation point is added to the driving record by the DMV.

**You will be required to pay the bail amount plus a \$52.00 administrative fee to the Court. Upon payment, you will be given 90 days to complete a DMV-approved traffic school and return proof of completion to the court. Extensions will not be granted. If you fail to submit proof by the due date, a conviction will be reported to the DMV and a point will be added to your driving record. The school will charge a fee that is in addition to the amount paid to the court.**

If there are any correctable violations on your citation, these corrections must be received along with any fees before permission will be granted.

***NOTICE:*** *If you are eligible and decide not to attend traffic school, your automobile insurance and driving record may be adversely affected. One conviction in any 18-month period will be held confidential and not show on your driving record if you complete traffic school*
